Drugs Warrants

Bridgnorth Safer Neighbourhood team, along with colleagues from other departments, including officers from the Dogs unit, have conducted two Search Warrants in the Bridgnorth area. The first was in Low Town, where a quantity of class A and Class B drugs were seized and the resident of the property was arrested.

The second successful warrant was carried out in a rural area close to Bridgnorth whereby a large Cannabis cultivation was discovered and subsequently dismantled. A number of people at the location were arrested.
